SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST LAND REGULATIONS

A NY PEISON who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta.

Duties—Six months' residence upon and clearing of the land for a period of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of the homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres, or within the limits of a city, town or village, if the land is required to be cleared.
