SALARY OF GREAT SINGERS

John McCormack, the singer, has put into the hands of Mark Fisher, collector of internal revenue for the third of New York District, a cheque for \$75,000, a sum equal to the annual salary of the President, which represented Mr. McCormack's income tax for the year. This exceeds by \$16,000 the income tax paid by Enrico Caruso three weeks ago, and is believed to represent an income of approximately \$300,000 a year.
