LONDON'S LORD MAYOR.

LONDON'S LORD MAYOR.

When Arrayed in His Robes of Six His Glory is like Unto Solomon's. (From the London Telegraph.)

The fountain of municipal honor england undenbtedly springs from a Guildhell, London, whice justly claims be accounted the most ancient of our mucipal hails, seeing that the Lord Mayors the last eight centuries are with just assumed to have had prototypes in Roman Prefect and the Saxon Fortreye Portgrave. For a considerable number years the robes of the Lord Mayor, a court of aldermen and the common cer cilors have been settled with a precision that none, save the most reckless of in vators, would presume to disturb. The Lord Mayor himself has his "gold" rofor the occasion of the annual Guildh banquet and for the times when he piceeds in state either to the new law control to the Houses of Parliament. The aldermen have their scarlet gowns, the sheritheir distinctive and very handsome rod and chains, while the common councilorejoice in gowns called "mazarines," being generally understood that mazari is a term for a particular dark blue cole although, according to some lexicographer mazarine also means a drinking vessel an an old way of dressing fowls.

Then, again, when the Sovereign cominto the city the Lord Mayor is bound to don a robe of crimson or purple velve trimmed with ermine. At the time of hinvestiture he wears a massive gold chair but, when he is honored by re-election at the expiration of his term of office he wear two chains. The mace of silver-gilt, su mounted by a royal crown and the imperial arms, is carried before the mayor by the authority of the charter of Edward HII. while the city possesses no less than four swords, one called the "Pearl," presente by Queen Bess when she opened the first Royal Exchange, and so called from it being richly set with pearls. This sword precedes the chief magistrate on all coassions of rejoicing and festivity. The sword of state is carried before the Lord Mayor's chair at the Central Criminal Court.
