WEEKLY REVIEW.

LONDON, Wednesday, Jan. 4.

There was no change in the value of any kind of grain except corn since the last weekly review.

Wheat closed steady at \$1 for red and \$1.03 for white.

Oats firm and supply light at 85c to 86c.

Barley and buckwheat, 80c.

Corn, about 90c for yellow and 85c for white.

Beans dull and \$1 for hand-picked.

No rye offered; \$1 was spoken of as its value.

Sales of clover seed were made at \$4.50 for red, peas quiet at 10c to 10 1/2c.

There has been an exceedingly uncertain market for eggs for the entire week, and most sales have depended entirely upon the buyer.

Wool had been run all the way from 22c to 27c per dozen, and the cause for so wide a range seems to have been the fact that transactions are covered by the outside figures, did not look so much upon the cost of the eggs as upon the surety that they were really fresh laid. To-day's value for new wool was 25c by the single dozen, and 20c by the basket.

Fresh store lots gathered within a fortnight of sale, 20c; packed, 18c.

Flour in single pound rolls sold at 20c to 21c; round rolls in baskets at 18c to 20c; large rolls in sacks, 18c; tubs or firkins, 18c to 19c.

There was very little business done in the latter, only a few being offered, and the price given would be for choice stock.

The supply of turkeys was small and a good demand made prices high, 10c to 11c per lb being paid, and in some cases 12c.

Dressed hogs active at \$7.50 to \$7.80 for choice, ranging at \$6.50.

Trading in all other lines steady and values unchanged.

EAST BUFFALO, N. Y., Jan. 3.—Cattle—

200 only on sale; yesterday's prices were 15c to 20c lower; 5 cars received to-day and 10 cars held over; market dull at yesterday's decline.

The local market—Butcher's prices on sale yesterday, including 10 cars Canada; for choice the market was dull at 10c to 20c lower.

Today 27 cars on sale, including 10 cars Canada; local butchers bought freely; not much outside demand; Canada sold freely at \$9 1/2 to \$9 3/4 and closed fairly strong. Some good Canadian sheep brought \$5, and the prospects for sheep are better; if the quality is good.

Hogs—Offerings yesterday were 35 cars; market strong. Today 8 cars were on sale; market active and higher; 8 light pigs were in good demand again and sold nearly up to good Yorkers and packers; good to choice Yorkers brought \$7 10 to \$7 15; good pigs, \$7 to \$7 10, and two or three decks of good mediums and heavy brought \$7 25 to \$7 30.

TORONTO.

TORONTO, Jan. 3.—Trade in cattle is beginning to pick up again, but it will be a week or two before much vim returns. Receipts at the Western cattle market today were larger, there being 20 cars on offer. These included 100 sheep and lambs, 175 hogs and half a dozen thin calves. The attendance of buyers was only fair.

Butcher's Cattle—There was a fair local demand, and 5 or 6 cars were bought for the local market. Receipts were 35 cars; 100 head of wool carriers offered, mostly all of which were lambs.

Calves—A few good calves would sell readily at present, none of which were on offer to-day.

Hogs—All of the 175 hogs on sale were sold quickly at figures ranging from \$5 75 to \$8 10 per cwt. of live weight.
