# The Hospital For The Insane

Annual Report of the Medical Superintendent in Charge of Asylum.

Statistical Tables Relating to the Workings of the Institution.

An extremely interesting document for all who take an intelligent concern in efforts to benefit their unfortunate fellow-men, is the annual report of the New Westminster hospital for the insane, prepared by Dr. Manchester, the medical superintendent in charge, and transmitted to the legislature by the Provincial Secretary. Attached to the report are the usual statistical tables, a comparison of which with those of prepared by the bene set of patients have been dealt with, and that the work of the hospital has been extended in every direction.
