Toronto has hitherto had a good record as regards freedom from epidemic. Some sanitary measures have been taken in this city, but the World regrets to state that at present our city, which should be one of the healthiest in the Dominion, is suffering from being in a satisfactory sanitary condition.

The evil has now been pointed out, the Health Officer of the city has explained the reasons for the epidemic, and the public has been universally notified to the preventive nature of such a disease.

There is nothing new in the position of affairs at the Smallpox Hospital. The number of patients have not increased, and the Committee of the Board of Health has taken steps to improve the hospital.
