NOVA SCOTIA SERVICE.

A part of our summer service of 1897 is intended to give special accommodation to Nova Scotia travel. The steamship "St. Croix," recently built, will make the time from Boston to St. John direct in about 181-2 hours, leaving Boston on Mondays and Thursdays at 10.30 A.M., connecting at St. John the next morning with S.S. "Prince Rupert," arriving at Digby about 9.15 A.M., reaching Halifax and all points in the Land of Evangeline the same afternoon.

Tourists who desire to make a more extended Coast trip, may take the steamers Cumberland or State of Maine, which leave Boston on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays at 8.45 A. M., for St. John, via Portland, Lubec and Eastport.
