#### Miscellancons.

A FEW sprigs of celery tops placed about a dish of cold sliced meat make it look more palatable.

EVERLASTINGS for winter bouquets should bu picked before they are quite open, tied up in bunches and hung in the shade to dry.

A pretty pedestal on which to stand a bas-ket of flowers has the top, base, upper and lower parts of the shaft covered with red silk plush. In the centre is a band of black, wrought in irregular zigzags of gold, with flowers and foliage in silk embroidery.

TO CRYSTALLIZE PLUMS.—Take one pound of loaf sugar, dip the lumps into water and place them in a kettle. Let it boil, skimming it carefully until it candys. Dip the fruit into this while it is very hot; then put the fruit in a cool room. Stems of raisins and bunches of grapes may be treated in the same way. Halves of pears crystallized are delicious.

ALMOND MILK.—Blanch one pound of sweet almonds with half a dozen bitter ones. Pound them to a pulp in a marble mortar, adding now and then a spoonful of water to prevent the almonds from boiling. Add a quart of water to them and stir well. Let the emulsion stand half an hour in a cool place, then strain through a napkin and sweeten to taste.

ROLY POLY PUDDING.—One cup of sour ROLY POLY PUDDING.—One cup of sour milk, one egg, one tablespoonful of driping, three small teaspoonfuls of baking powder; mix stiff and roll thin in an oblong form; spread fruit plentifully over the pastry and, beginning at one end, roll the crust over the fruit. Envelope in a pudding bag, or wrapt in a towel, and place in a vessel of boiling water. Let the pudding boil briskly at hour. Serve hot, with sauce. This is an excellent receipe for cherry, raspberry whorlieberry and blackberry pudding. It is quickly made and is wholesome and delicious.

A Young CHICKEN OUT OF AN OLD ONE.—Partont the chicken, and when the wing—the toughest part of any fowl—can be pierced with a broom-splint without effort, take in opt of the keule, drain it well and cut in pieces as for a flicassee. Put one pint of cream into a large trying-pan; let it become heated, then lay the chicken into the pan. Let it cook in the cream until it is all of a rich brown; then pour the cream out into a small saucepan, put a lump of butter in with the chicken; after it melts, turn the chicken over, so that it will be browned slike on both sides. Inchen the cream with a little flour, and serve as gravy in a boat; or, after purting the chicken on the platter, pour the cream over it.
