RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA

In cases where the Government of Canada is responsible for the following expenditures, based on the rates authorized in its regulations:

1. Expenditures relating to Burkina Faso scholarship holders:

- (a) tuition and tuition fees, books, supplies or materials required;
- (b) a living allowance;
- (c) medical and hospital expenses;
- (d) transport charges for travel by air or any other approved means of transport, in compliance with the requirements of the scholarship program.

2. Expenditures relating to Canadian Government in Burkina Faso:

- (a) travel expenses and those of their dependants, between their normal place of residence and their place of assignment in Burkina Faso;
- (b) travel expenses and those of their dependants, between their normal place of residence and the site of their temporary assignment, for the purpose of their assignment;
- (c) the cost of shipping, between their normal place of residence and their place of assignment in Burkina Faso, their personal and professional effects, their dependants, and the personal and professional effects required for the execution of their duties.

3. Expenditures relating to the project:

- (a) the cost of engineering, architectural and other services required for the execution of the project;
- (b) the cost of providing mechanical, electrical, material, medical equipment, and other goods and transporting the same to the point of entry in Burkina Faso.
