Tariff Impacts of Free Trade

The U.S. tariff on Portland cement was 22 cents/t including the weight of the container. Under the Free Trade Agreement, Portland Cement became duty free on January 1, 1989. All other cements continue to be duty free.

Tariff Impacts of Free Trade

U.S. tariffs on chocolate preparations ranged from 2.5% to 10%. Under the Free Trade Agreement, these tariffs will be reduced in ten equal stages so that by January 1, 1998, chocolate preparations will become duty free.
