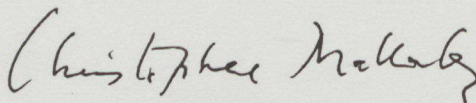
Your Excellency,

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your Note of 25 September 1990 concerning the Convention on the Presence of Foreign Forces in the Federal Republic of Germany of 23 October 1954, the English text of which reads as follows:

(See German Note of September 25, 1990)

I have the honour to inform you that the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland agree to the content of Your Excellency's Note. Accordingly, Your Excellency's Note, this reply and the replies of the Ambassador of the Kingdom of Belgium, of the Ambassador of Canada, of the Ambassador of the Kingdom of the Netherlands and of the Ambassador of the United States of America expressing their Governments' agreement shall constitute an Agreement between our Governments.

I avail myself of this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurances of my highest consideration.
