

- Principal Canadian exports are fertilizers (potash), polyethylene, sulphur, machinery, softwood lumber and canned salmon. Inroads are being made in the more value-added sectors, such as computer hardware and software, telecommunications equipment and consumer products.
- Major imports from New Zealand include beef and lamb, fruit, dairy products and fish.
- New Zealand invests more than \$3 billion in Canada. Fletcher Challenge Ltd. leads the way with investments in the forestry sector in British Columbia and in the oil and gas sectors in Alberta and Saskatchewan. Canadian investment in New Zealand exceeds \$1.5 billion.
- Canadian joint ventures in New Zealand include projects by TransAlta Energy Resources (thermal power generation and electrical utilities), Methanex (methanol production), Bell Canada and CanWest Global (television).
