

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE NATIONAL AERONAUTICS
AND SPACE ADMINISTRATION OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND THE
CANADIAN SPACE AGENCY CONCERNING SPACE SHUTTLE FLIGHT ACTIVITIES
FOR THE CANEX-2 PAYLOAD**

The National Aeronautics and Space Administration of the United States of America (hereinafter referred to as "NASA") and the Canadian Space Agency (hereinafter referred to as "CSA"), hereinafter jointly referred to as the "Parties";

Recalling with satisfaction the considerable amount of cooperation already conducted between the United States and Canada in the area of space science and space technology;

Desiring to pursue continued cooperation in the area of utilization of space;

Noting the Space Station Intergovernmental Agreement and the bilateral Memorandum of Understanding on Cooperation in the Detailed Design, Development, Operation and Utilization of the Permanently Manned Civil Space Station of September 29, 1988; and

Convinced that collaboration will continue to produce benefits for both Parties;
