CANADA HOSTS CONFERENCE ON THE ENVIRONMENT AS A WEAPON OF WAR

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Barbara McDougall, today announced that External Affairs and International Trade Canada and the United Nations will co-sponsor a conference in Ottawa, July 10-12, 1991, preventing the use of the environment as a weapon of war.

"Iraq's deliberate dumping of oil into the Persian Gulf during the Gulf conflict left long-lasting, devastating damage to the environment," said Mrs. McDougall. "This conference is a major step to ensure that the environment is never again used as a weapon of war."


Experts from around the world will review the existing body of international law and discuss ways to improve its effectiveness and implementation.
