Twenty change orders resulted from unforeseen job conditions; nine change orders resulted from revised client requirements after contract award; one change order involved requirements to meet fire regulations; one change order was due to rock conditions not being as shown on documents resulting in additional excavation; five change orders resulted from changes in Department of Public Works requirements subsequent to contract award; one change order was to ensure the safety of employees and one change order was required to comply with Ontario Hydro safety codes.
