- Federal Labour Intensive Program Additional labour intensive expenditures by the federal government to ease winter unemployment. Announced in the June 23 budget.
- CIDA Aid program for 1975-76 at \$903 million is expected to equal .565 of 1 percent of GNP. The 1976-77 level of \$1,000 million is expected to equal only .541 of 1 percent of GNP.
- Shipbuilding Subsidies The Shipbuilding Assistance Program provides a subsidy of 14 percent on ships constructed in Canada. The percentage will decline gradually to 8 percent in six years.
- Railway Relocation and Crossing Act, Part 2 Special assistance provided where the costs of railway grade separation projects (under Part 3) exceed statutory limits.
- Treasury Board Contingencies Vote Departments carry a prescribed partial allowance for general salary increases in their votes. The Treasury Board carries another amount to make up the difference from the expected total. With the introduction of wage guidelines with the 8 + 2 + 2 formula, it was thought safe to reduce the contingency fund.
