After some time the House was resumed, and

The Honorable Mr. *Reesor*, from the said Committee, reported that they had gone through the said Bill, and had directed him to report the same to the House without any amendment.

On motion of the Honorable Mr. *Scott*, seconded by the Honorable Mr. *Letellier de St. Just*, it was

Ordered, That the said Bill be read a third time presently.

The said Bill was then read a third time accordingly.

The question was put whether this Bill shall pass?

It was resolved in the affirmative.

Ordered, That the Clerk do go down to the House of Commons, and acquaint that House that the Senate have passed this Bill, without any amendment.

The House, according to Order, was adjourned during pleasure, and put into a Committee of the Whole on the Bill intituled: "An Act to amend the Act respecting the Trinity House and Harbour Commissioners of Montreal."

After some time the House was resumed, and

The Honorable Mr. *Kaulbach* from the said Committee, reported that they had taken the said Bill into consideration, had made some progress therein, and had directed him to ask leave to sit again.

On motion of the Honorable Mr. *Scott*, seconded by the Honorable Mr. *Letellier de St. Just*, it was

Ordered, That the said Committee have leave to sit again at the next sitting of the House.

The Honorable Mr. *Hamilton (Kingston)*, from the Committee on Banking, Commerce and Railways, to whom was referred the Bill intituled: "An Act respecting the Albion Mines Savings' Bank," reported that they had gone through the said Bill, and recommend that it be no further proceeded with.

The Honorable Mr. *Wilmot* moved, seconded by the Honorable Mr. *Leonard*,

That the said Report be not adopted, and that the said Bill be read a third time presently.

After Debate,

On motion of the Honorable Mr. *Letellier de St. Just*, seconded by the Honorable Mr. *Scott*, it was

Ordered, That further Debate on the said motion be postponed until the next sitting of the House.
