(3) The proceedings of a Committee of the Whole shall be entered in the Journals of the Senate.
66. (1) At the commencement of each session a Committee of Selection consisting of nine senators shall be appointed whose duties shall be to nominate:
(a) a senator to preside as Speaker pro tempore;
(b) the senators to serve on the several select committees.
(2) The Committee of Selection shall, within the first five sitting days of each session, present a separate report to the Senate in respect of its nomination of a senator to preside as Speaker pro tempore pursuant to paragraph (1)(a).
(3) Subject to subsection (4), the senator nominated under this Rule shall, when their appointments are confirmed by the Senate, serve for the duration of the session for which they are appointed.
(4) Subject to subsection (5), a change in the membership of a committee may be made by a notice filed with the Clerk of the Senate who shall cause such change to be recorded in the Minutes of the Proceedings of the Senate.
(5) The notice referred to in subsection (4) shall be signed:
(a) with respect to Government members, by the Leader of the Government in the Senate or any senator named by him, and
(b) with respect to Opposition members, by the Leader of the Opposition in the Senate or any senator named by him.
67. (1) The standing committees shall be as follows:
(a) The Joint Committee on the Library of Parliament to which shall be appointed seventeen senators.
