would review the situation and give us clear, reasonable, logical criticism—criticism that, though it might come from hostile ranks, would yet add to the efficiency of that great council of the nation for the excellence and effectiveness of which my hon. friend the member for Bothwell (Mr. Mills) is so much and so laudably concerned.
