The Planet *Venus* (♀) will be *Evening Star* until September 28th; then *Morning Star* to the end of the year.—*Mars* (♂) will be *Evening Star* until October 2nd; then *Morning Star* to the end of the year.—*Jupiter* (♃) will be *Morning Star* until April 12th; then *Evening Star* until October 31st; then *Morning Star* to the end of the year.—*Saturn* (♄) will be *Morning Star* until March 23rd; then *Evening Star* until October 2nd; then *Morning Star* to the end of the year.
