## BY-LAWS.

## INTERNATIONAL LUDGE, No. 228

## MEMBERSHIP.

1.—One week's notice shall be given verbally in open Lodge, of intention to propose a candidate for membership.

2.—No application for membership shall be made known to any person not a member of this Order, until after the same shall have been determined favourably by election.

3.—Application or membership shall be in the prescribed form, and shall be accompanied by the sum of two dollars (\$2), which sum shall be placed to the credit of the candidate's initiation fee, provided he shall appear for initiation within thirteen (13) weeks; otherwise, such deposit shall be placed to the credit of the General Benefit Fund; but, in the event of rejection, it shall be returned to the candidate by the Lodge; the candidate must furnish a medical certificate from the examining physician of the Lodge, on the form provided by the Grand Lodge. Cost of certificate to be borne by the candidate.

4.—Every Brother, on his admission to the Lodge, shall sign an agreement to abide by its Constitution and By-laws, and to pay all legal demands against him, so long as he shall remain a member thereof; and shall give his place of residence to the P. S., and whenever he changes his residence he shall notify the P. S. of such change, or forfeit his claim to the attention of the Visiting Committee.

5.—No Brother shall enter or retire from the Lodge during the ceremony of Initiation or conferring Degrees.

6. In balloting for members, the ballot-box shall be placed in full view of the N. G., and the result having been inspected
