On comparing the above with the statement presented a year ago, it will be observed that the payments for stipends and pensions have been less during 1877, by the sum of \$1,568.24, than in 1876.

The venerable Society for the propagation of the Gospel, after repeated intimations of her intention, has carried into effect her purpose of reducing the grant to this Diocese, and for the current year we shall receive but £1,800, instead of £2,000 stig.
