
ARTICLE X.**ARBITRATION.**

The Grand Factor or in his absence the Deputy Grand Factor shall preside over all meetings of the Arbitration and Appeal Committee and Grand Secretary shall attend and take the Minutes thereof, they shall have no vote, the casting vote of the Grand Factor, when necessary, excepted.

Should the Grand Factor or Deputy Grand Factor be interested in any case on Arbitration or Appeal or belong to the Post appealing or Appealed against, the Committee shall appoint others from among themselves who are not interested in the case; the Chairman so appointed shall have a casting vote only when necessary.

No case can be adjudicated unless a quorum of five members are present, nor unless thirty one clear days notice in writing of the time and hearing has been served through the Recording Secretary of the Sub-Post. Such notice shall be by registered letter.

ARTICLE XI.**DISPENSATION.**

A Dispensation to open a Post of Native Sons shall on the application of 15 male persons or more be granted upon payment of the sum of Ten dollars.

Applicants must be of good moral character, and born within the Province of British Columbia or whose birth is registered therein, and of the full age of 18 years. The cost of Rituals necessary is included with the dispensation.

ARTICLE XII.**AUDITORS.**

The Finance Committee appointed at the Annual Meeting shall audit and report at the next meeting of the Grand Post upon the books of the Grand Secretary and Grand Treasurer.

ARTICLE XIII.**AMENDMENTS TO CONSTITUTIONS, BY-LAWS OR RULES.**

All proposed amendments to the Constitutions, By-laws or Rules of the Grand Post, must be passed in a Sub-Post
