CAP. I.

UNIVERSITY OFFICERS.

---

§ 1. Whereas it is directed in the Royal Charter of the University of Trinity College:—

“That there shall be at all times a Chancellor of the said University, to be chosen at and for such periods of time and under such rules and regulations as the College Council, by and with the sanction and approbation of the Lord Bishop or Bishops aforesaid, may by their statutes, rules, and ordinances to be from time to time passed for that purpose think fit to appoint;” be it ordained :

1. That the Chancellor be elected by the Corporation of Trinity College, at a meeting of the said Corporation, of which at least thirty days' notice shall have been given agreeably to an order of the Corporation, entered on their minutes.
2. That the Chancellor be elected for a period of two years ; but that he shall retain his office for such time beyond that period as the tacit consent of the Corporation shall allow.
