## CAP. I.

## UNIVERSITY OFFICERS.

- § 1. Whereas it is directed in the Royal Charter of the University of Trinity College:—
  - "That there shall be at all times a Chancellor of the said University, to be chosen at and for such periods of
  - "time and under such rules and regulations as the
  - "College Council, by and with the sanction and approba-
  - "tion of the Lord Bishop or Bishops aforesaid, may by "their statutes, rules, and ordinances to be from time to
  - "time passed for that purpose think fit to appoint;" be it ordained:
  - 1. That the Chancellor be elected by the Corporation of Trinity College, at a meeting of the said Corporation, of which at least thirty days' notice shall have been given agreeably to an order of the Corporation, entered on their minutes.
  - 2. That the Chancellor be elected for a period of two years; but that he shall retain his office for such time beyond that period as the tacit consent of the Corporation shall allow.
