

EXPERTS DON'T CREDIT

A prominent mining engineer, interviewed by The World last night, said that he took no stock in the stories of diamonds in the north. He had traveled down nearly all the rivers in the James Bay country and he was never able to see bottom or anything like the bottom on account of the density of the water, which reeked with muck and vegetable matter.
