A BIG BATCH OF JUDGMENTS. Saturday an extremely busy Day with the Ontario Hall Justice—Other

The Queen v. Martin—Motion by defendant, pursuant to leave to appeal of chairman of sessions of County of York, after conviction for obtaining by false pretences, for a new trial granted and new trial ordered. Granting of bail will be considered.

Vermet v. defendant, J. R. Cartwright, C.C., for Crown. By Meredith, C.J., and MacMahon, J. Williams v. Holmes—Appeal by plaintiff from judgment of the County of York, dismissed with costs. Segworth for plaintiff. Haverson for defendant.

Rose, J., and MacMahon, J. Quebec Bank v. Taggart—Motion by plaintiff to set aside verdict of jury and judgment of Judge in favor of defendant allowed and judgment for plaintiff granted with costs. Field v. Bradley—Appeal by plaintiff from judgment of MacMahon, J., allowed with new trial ordered. Field for plaintiff. W. J. McKay (Orangeville) for defendant. Atkin—Appeal by plaintiff from order of Boyd, C., in chambers, dismissing application for summary judgment upon his examination as a judgment debtor, dismissed without costs. Rose for defendant. Stokes v. Simpson—Motion by defendant to set aside judgment for \$75, in action for slander, granted with costs. Aylesworth, C.C., for defendant. W. M. Douglas for plaintiff. Quach et al. v. Motion for rule nisi to quash return roll and writ of f. fa. and capias by writs, on a recognition given before Police Magistrate, J. Toronto on the ground that Cohen was not arraigned at next court of competent jurisdiction, granted. Lindsey for motion.

May v. Bellfield (and five other actions)—Appeal by plaintiff from orders of Boyd, C., and Street, J., affirming orders of Master in Chambers and Court because plaintiff was insolvent and without beneficial interests in the subject-matter of actions and costs of proceedings for sale of real estate, dismissed with costs. The court withheld judgment for the present and stayed proceedings until the plaintiff, Schoff, W. E. Midgerton and A. B. Armstrong, for defendant. Such proceedings as are necessary to be made (sealed) free.

LOOKING AT THINGS UNSURE. A Rochester Divine Tells How it is Done. The Marvellous Results. Members of Elm-street Methodist Church, ministers, laymen, numbers at the anniversary services of this historic church. They were delighted with the unaccompanied Rev. Dr. Hayes of Rochester, a man in the prime of life, of medium height, with bushy dark hair, smart mustache and an agreeable style of speaking. Eloquent he was not, but the congregations hung on his words, for there was a deep vein of sympathy in them, and all his points were emphasized with apt illustrative anecdotes.

Rev. Dr. Galbraith, the pastor, took a share in the services, and pleaded that the liberality of the congregation might reach \$300, a sum the trustees are anxious to raise for pressing needs. Dr. Hayes' morning discourse was based on St. Paul's words in II. Cor. IV.

For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory. While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for all things which are seen are temporal, but the things which are not seen are eternal.

The preacher dealt with the temptation to regard this world as the only thing which can be seen and handled. How illustrious these views are he showed by reference to the disappearance of the great works of ancient architecture. He was the more convincing in his references to the one-time, old familiar faces. The rule held good also in commercial and political affairs, and even in the very "O" for the touch of a vanished hand, and the sound of a voice that is no more.

Turning to the second division of his subject, "looking at things which are not seen," he showed that it was not incongruous as might be supposed. He instanced as potent, though unseen, how electricity, sympathy, and even telepathy, patriotic, tidal waves of emotion. How unseen things have influenced and stimulated great souls in every age. Dr. Hayes admirably showed, the chief biblical characters instanced by Moses, Daniel, Paul and Stephen.

In pleading later for a big collection the Doctor said: "When a man is urged to give, he is urged to give to the bottom of his pocket, he will regard his banking account as a contract with the Lord."

In the evening the sermon was more especially for young people. The subject was "Life-Saving Principles." This evening in the same church Dr. Hayes gives his position on "Great Women and Their Husbands."

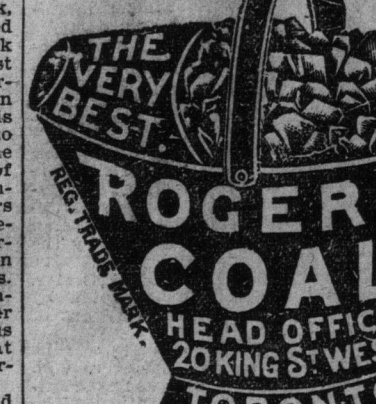
