LABOR STRIKE IN SIGHT
SINCE ARBITRATION FAILS
Labor Organizations Decide to Give Chicago the Greatest Battle of the Century.

Chicago, Nov. 16.—(3 a.m. bulletin).—Arbitration failing in the present crisis, the Chicago Federation of Labor and the Chicago Federation of Masters have decided to give Chicago the greatest battle of the century.

It is expected that action will end in the calling of a general strike against the Chicago Traction Company, all the elevated companies, the South Chicago Electric Company, the Calumet Electric Company, the Chicago General Electric Company, the Suburban Electric Company and the Chicago Electric Traction Company.

Chicago, Nov. 17.—Peace negotiations between the management of the Chicago City Railway and its striking employees were begun today and the indications are that both sides will agree to arbitration. After a conference between Mayor Harrison and the officials of the company and the special aldermanic peace commission and President Mahon of the Amalgamated Association of Street Railway Employees and his legal advisors, Mayor Harrison declared that the outlook for a settlement of the strike was decidedly bright.

Violence Broke Out
While the City Council last night was engaged in a debate over the relations of the police to the city railway strike, the sidewalk in front of the City Hall was the scene of a riot.

Ottawa, Nov. 17.—The Free Press, Liberal organ, to-night announces editorially: "The writ for the North Renfrew election will be issued next week, and the election itself will take place within six weeks. This information comes from the best source, and of its reliability there can be no doubt."
