# \$70,000

## In Debt.

The property of the Hospital for Sick Children, together with the furnishings, fittings and the best surgical appliances in the world, is worth \$213,000.

Against it there is a debt of \$70,000—and paying interest thereon causes a big annual deficit.

The liquidation of this debt would free the institution from a great weight—and the hospital work could be further extended.

It cannot be done in a moment.

This year the trustees make an appeal for \$20,000.

But \$70,000 should be provided.

There are seventy gentlemen in Ontario who could easily spare \$1,000 each.

There are 140 gentlemen, from whom a gift of \$500 each would be most acceptable.

If they walked through the Hospital, saw the nature of the work, the thorough system and splendid equipment, the Hospital for Sick Children would not need to further beg. Will those who can visit the Hospital? Visitors are welcome.
