Your Committee would also recommend, that the affairs of Rose Lodge, No. 28, be closed up if possible, and that a Committee be appointed for that purpose.

Your Committee regret that misunderstandings have occurred in some Lodges, in reference to the Constitution and By-Laws, and would recommend that the Committee on Laws of Subordinates take the matter into consideration, and that so much of the Grand Master's Report as refers to Appeals, and to questions asked by different Lodges, be referred to the Committee on Appeals.

Your Committee would recommend, with regard to the permanent location of the Grand Lodge, that no permanent location be decided on at the present Session.

Your Committee would also recommend, that the Grand Secretary be allowed some remuneration for his valuable services as Secretary of this Grand Lodge.
