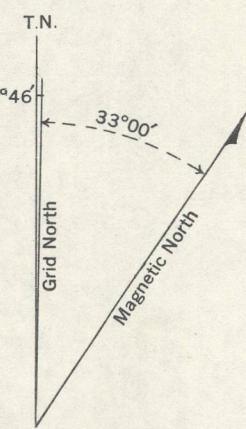

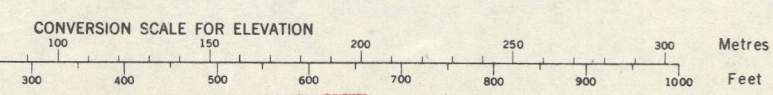
APPROXIMATE MEAN DECLINATION 1949 FOR CENTER OF SHEET
