Order in Council passed the respecting timber on patented lands, Old Lands on the North Shore of the, the absolute right to the growing timber on said lands required on payment being made to the Crown of Lanark, at the rate of one dollar per acre, in addition to the dollar per acre paid, or to be paid in future.

Patented Lands, and purchasers of sale of which are now being offered at the desire of acquiring the Pine Timber thereon, are hereby notified for such right, and make application, within six months from notice.

As to purchase Lands after date of sale are required to apply for the Pine Timber on said lands, the time on to purchase the lands and such right at the time of applications per acre as above additional to one dollar per acre of the Lands.

Owners of Patented Lands, or of Lands on sale on which are to fall to apply for the right to the Pine Trees on such six months from the date of the purchase of the lands, or to purchase the right to the Pine Trees at the time of application to apply for, and acquire the Pine Trees, on the Lands applied for the Pine Trees on such Lands will be by the Department of Crown Lands making application therefor, and the rate of time to purchase, but should there be no application for any space, or locality, the Pine Trees shall be awarded to the highest bidder, and the amount per acre over fifty cents.
