

and consequently
provisions cannot be
sent. The Dept. will,
however, sanction the
extension by the Missionary
at that place, of relief
to an amount not to
exceed ^{the other} two hundred
dollars to the Indians
between Nebraskawan
and Bonne Esperance;
but this grant must be
considered as altogether
exceptional, being necessitated
by the peculiar position
in which those Indians
are this year placed owing
to the circumstances
described by your letter,
and which may not
occur again for years.
The Indians to whom relief
is given should ^{therefore} be made
to understand that the
grant is not necessarily
to be repeated another
year.

Upon receipt of copies
showing in detail the
quantity, descriptions
and value of relief given
the names of the heads of families
the number in each family
family to whom relief is
being furnished, all
certified by the Missionary
and if possible by the Chief
