Mestructiones for Lowrence Clack the Interp:

I Mereas we have received advice that the French al Canada make preporations to attack the building at ofwego this Spring w. Theor Indians; which we think is an affair of Such Moments to the Province, of the French do Succeed ins their design, I hat it ought to be prevented in the best manners possible. We therefore thought fitte to dende you to dequaint the Sachimes of the Six Nationer w: this undertakeing of the French, and that the demolishing of the Said building will be Very detrementall to them as well as to us, and Surround them, on all vides, while they have abready had jufficient proofs of the French fortifying near them, and that they have on Severalls Flaces made Fortifications without their Converts. But this building hav been breched by their Convents and is a Defence & Jeworthy to them, They have Sufficients Instances of the Pivil Treatments and winds behaviour of this Governm. Towards them for their Security and wellfare for many years part, Wherefore Twee fann of doubt but the Nachune will performe their repeated From iver, in a frishing and Defending the Said building In fave It Should be attacked, Wherefore you are in the name The Decy. Governour Montgomeru to desvie the Sachuns of the vice Nations to Send up two Sachims of Each Nation to goup to Ofwego forthwith, and Lye there untill Such Time The French Should attack the house at ofwego, That they will Tell the French that the English have built that house by their orders and upon their grounds, and that whomsoever Should make an attack to demolish that house that they -Would Deem it an attempt on their own fartlesse
