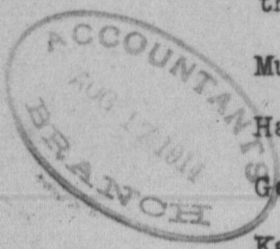

Sir,-

I beg to inform you that Angus Anderson No:7 of George Gordons Band married in December 1906 Sarah Jane McNab a non-treaty woman who she became a member of the Band by virtue of her marriage.

There have been five children born since their marriage, namely;-



- Muriel born June 29th: 1907
- Harold " Feb 10th: 1909
- George " Jan 19~~11~~¹⁶: 1911
- Katie " " Sept 6 1912
- Daughter " July 20 1914

This man refused to have his wife and children taken on the treaty books until this year when on July the 4th: the date of the payments at Gordons reserve he made application for the annuity and arrears for his wife and four children.

I paid them their annuity for 1914, together with one years arrears for each person in accordance with the regulations.

The following arrears are still due;-

- Muriel " 1908/09/10/11/12/12 (6)
- Harold " 1910/11/12/13 (4)
- George " 1910/ 11/ 12/13 (2)
