
Ottawa 4th November 1902-

Sir-

In reply to your letter of the 30th Ultimo enclosing report of examination and valuation by Mr. McAuley of lands in the Township of Pennefather, I beg to return the same, in order that it may be made under oath, in accordance with instructions ~~sent~~ contained in letter addressed you on the 18th September last.

It will be necessary for Mr. McAuley to make Statutory Declaration to accompany the report, showing that he has examined the lands therein referred to and that his report contains a just and true account of the value and extent of the arable land contained therein and also of the possible quantity and values of the different kinds of timber specified therein.
