In view of the report contained in your letter of the 21st ultimo, I beg to say that the Department approves of the issue of supplies for the destitute at Cross Lake being placed in the hands of constable Wayman, of the R. It might be well for you to inform Mrs. Gaudin and the missionary that they should bring to the Wonsstable's notice any cases of destitution which require attention.
