- Q. Apparently from what you tell me, the lot you occupy
- is lot 188? A. It must be yes.
- Q. And your mother-in-law Mrs. Cameron occupies lot 187?
- A. Yes, that must be it.
- Q. Your lot and hers are each a little over two chains?
- A. Very very little
- Q. When did you move on your lot?
- A. Well, I could not tell the date.
- Q. Before the transfer or afterwards?
- A. A long time after.
- Q. When did you get mattied.
- A. Well, I could not exactly tell you.
- Q. It was after the transfer? A. Oh yes.
- Q. And when you went there your mother-in-law was living on her own lot? A. Oh yes.
- Q. Can you tell me anything about who occupied this lot
- 187 at the time of the transfer? A. Yes, old Cameron
- Q. Old Cameron occupied it at the time of the transfer?
- A. Ye, just himself.
- Q. Did he occupy just the two chains? A. That is all.
- Q. You dont know anything about his selling it?
- A. I do not know anything about it. I f I should tell you I should say "this man told me," and so on. That is not evidence at all.
