FORM OF ORDER FOR COMMITMENT TO PRISON, MILITARY OR CIVIL
(OR TO A DETENTION BARRACK) OF PERSONS SUBJECT TO MILITARY
LAW SENTENCED TO IMPRISONMENT

To the governor or chief officer in charge of (a) Québec P-Q Civil
prison (or detention barrack) at Québec P-Q
Whereas M-101716, P.Q. (A/Lgt) Smith Collins Lindberg of the
1st war disease control station C-A- was by
a (b) District Court Martial held at The Drill Hall,
Québec P-Q convicted of the offence of (c) Wilfully giving false
evidence when examined under oath before a court martial.

And by a sentence signed on the 19th, day of August 1944.
Sentenced (d) to be imprisoned with (e) hard labor for 12 months
Commencing on the aforesaid day, and such sentence has been confirmed by
The Superior.

Military Authorities As required by law
(f) Who However remitted 6 Months of the term of imprisonment
With hard labor

Now therefore I, the undersigned the competent authority do hereby in
pursuance of the army act and of all other acts and powers enabling me in
this behalf order you receive the said person into your custody and detain
him to undergo his said sentence according to law, and for so doing this
shall be your warrant.
