MEMORANDUM to Comptroller of Water Rights.

A further examination of the works constructed in pursuance of an agreement between His Majesty as represented by the Supt. General of Indian Affairs and Cosens Spencer, was made on the 13th of July last.

Paragraph 7 of the agreement provides that the work be done to the satisfaction of the District Engineer appointed under the Water Act of British Columbia, and of the party of the Second part (Cosens Spencer).

I HEREBY CERTIFY that the works are of sufficient capacity to carry the water under the respective licences; that the headgates on the Big Creek ditch; that the headgates and diversion dam on Menton Creek; that the gates on the main ditches leading to the Indian laterals are all satisfactory to me as District Engineer appointed under the Water Act of B.C.
