By order of His Excellency the Governor General in Council, dated the 15th June, 1893, the price of mineral lands controlled by the Department of Indian Affairs and consisting of surveyed townships situated in what are known as the Garden River, Batchewana and Goulais Bay tracts, lying north and east of Sault Ste. Marie, in the District of Algoma, has been reduced to \$4.00 per acre.
