The members of the Common Council are elected by a majority of the registered voters of the city of Toronto. The lists of persons entitled to vote for each ward are exhibited in the City Hall, from the first Monday in December until the day of the election (the second Tuesday in January). Persons interested should make a point of seeing that their names are not omitted or mis-spelt, as no alterations in such lists can be made unless four days' notice is given in writing to the Clerk of the Common Council of the desire to have any name altered, inserted, or erased, and no one is allowed to vote whose name does not appear on the said lists.
