

THE REMOVAL OF HEADQUARTERS TO BEINN BHREAGH.

Letters and telegrams from Hammondsport indicate that aeroplane No. 4, McCurdy's Silver-Dart is now practically completed, and that the machine may take the air any day.

It is understood by all the members that the Association's headquarters will be removed to Beinn Bhreagh, Near Baddeck, Nova Scotia, after sufficient time has elapsed to afford Mr. McCurdy full opportunity of testing out his machine at Hammondsport.

A meeting of the Association must be held at Beinn Bhreagh on the 30th of September to decide upon the future of the Association, as this is the day when the Association, in accordance with its agreement of organization, expires by time limitation, unless some other arrangement is unanimously agreed upon by the members. It is therefore urged that the Hammondsport members should come to Beinn Bhreagh as soon as practicable.

Lieut. Selfridge, our Secretary, has for some time past been in Washington, D.C., having been ordered there by the War Department. It is hoped that he too may be able to visit Beinn Bhreagh before the 30th of September for the continuance of the Association after that date, in its present, or in any modified form, requires the unanimous approval of the members. Should Lieut. Selfridge find that his presence at Beinn Bhreagh upon that date would be inconsistent with his military duties in Washington, D.C., he is specially requested to communicate his views concerning the future of the Association by letter to the Chairman, so that his vote may be recorded.
