So it was resolved in the Affirmative.

Then, the main Question, so amended, being put;

Ordered, That the Bill be now re-committed to a Committee of the whole House, to

amend the same by leaving out the 33rd and 34th sub-sections of section 40.

The House accordingly resolved itself into the said Committee; and after some time spent therein, Mr. Speaker resumed the Chair; Mr. Dunkin reported, That the Committee had gone through the Bill, and made an amendment thereunto.

Ordered, That the report be now received.

Mr. Dunkin reported the Bill accordingly; and the amendment was read, and agreed to.

And the Question being proposed, That the Bill be now read the third time; The Honorable Mr. Alleyn moved, in amendment, seconded by Mr. Oliver, That all the words after "now," to the end of the Question, be left out, and the words "re-com-"mitted to a Committee of the whole House to amend the same, by adding, after section 1, "clause 61, the words: Provided always, that the decision of the Recorder may be revised "by any party aggrieved, by a Petition to any Judge of the Superior Court, or the Court "of Queen's Bench, who shall decide thereon forthwith; the said party having first "deposited with the Prothonotary of the Superior Court at Quebec, twenty dollars to meet "the costs of such revision," inserted instead thereof.

And the Question being put on the amendment; the House divided :- And it passed

The Bill was accordingly read the third time.
