EDITORIAL NOTES.

Mr. Jamieson, M. P., has given notice in the Dominion Parliament of a bill to amend certain clauses in the Canada Temperance Act. The bill is introduced at the instance of the Dominion Alliance, and it is anticipated if passed, that it will render the Act much more efficient in countries where it has been adopted. Some of these changes are important and it is to be hoped that the good sense of a majority of the house will pass the clauses mentioned in the proposed bill, and thus do away with many of the present uncertainties which exist and make it in many cases almost an impossibility to effectively carry out the law. The following are quoted as the changes proposed:

The first section of the bill proposes to amend the law so as to allow of the deposit of a petition in either of the following cases:—

The second and third sections make the Act applicable to British Columbia, which is not the case now, owing to the fact that no county organizations there.

The fourth has in view making of application to temporary judicial districts. The fifth section amends the act so that a repeal vote cannot be taken until after it has been in operation for two years and ten months. The sixth amends the provisions of the law in reference to the sale of liquor for medicinal purposes or for use in art, trade or manufactures. It provides that the druggist or vendor shall file certificates and make returns to the collector of inland revenue. It also proposes to impose a penalty on any medical man giving fraudulent or colorable certificates. The eighth section is intended to simplify the law in reference to the justice of the peace before whom prosecutions are brought. At present there is considerable trouble as to the jurisdiction of the police magistrate. The twelfth section will amend the search clause of the act. It is proposed to give police magistrates having jurisdiction under the act power to issue a search warrant in the first instance. Other sections will permit of a search warrant being issued at any time; at present it can only be issued during the day time. The last section provides for the application of penalties. It proposes that when a provincial or other public officer is prosecutor, the penalty shall be paid to him. In other cases half shall go to the prosecution and half to the treasury of the local municipality. The merits of the bill will be discussed at the meeting of the Dominion Alliance, which will be held shortly.

The Scott Act repeal election, which took place in Halifax, Ont., on March 7, resulted in the petition being carried by a majority of over 200. Various reasons are given by the friends of the Act to account for their defeat, which, it is stated has been illegally obtained, and there is talk already of endeavoring to quash the proceedings on these grounds. In the meantime the liquor dealers and their friends are said to be wild over their unexpected success, this being their first victory of the many attempts to repeal the Act in various constituencies.

The resolutions of the Grit Convention held in Quebec in October last have been laid before the Ontario Legislature and have been severely criticized by Mr. Meredith. As these resolutions will be before the local legislature of New Brunswick for discussion, we may expect to hear more about them from our members. In the meantime we publish the editorial comments of the *Empire* of March 2nd, on Mr. Meredith's speech.

"Mr. Meredith's speech on the Mercier resolutions was undoubtedly one of the ablest ever delivered in the Legislature of Ontario. Mr. Meredith was in good 'form'; his voice was clear, his manner well arranged, his choice of words all that could be desired. His mental attitude bold, aggressive and commanding, his arguments well-knit and conclusive—all backed by a moral power to which the justice of his cause and the fairness and manliness of the speaker's character lent irresistible force. His exposure of the purely party character of the Grit cause which assembled at Quebec to frame amendments to the Dominion constitution, in contrast with the self-sacrificing and patriotic motives of the Reformers and Conservatives who, having made all party feeling, met in the same city in 1864 to frame a new constitution for the scattered provinces of British North America, was most effective. His treatment of the disallowance question supplies one of the highest arguments yet advanced on that subject, while his citations from the speeches of reformers who took part in framing the constitution, from Hon. Edward Blake when Minister of Justice, and from Mr. Meredith's exposure of Mr. G. W. Ross's attitude in support of disallowance in the House of Commons, where that inconsistent gentleman made a resolution, the effect of which was to require the Dominion Government to retro the educational legislation of New Brunswick—a subject which the Legislature and courts of New Brunswick, the Dominion and Imperial Governments, and the highest Court of the Empire, successively maintained was within the exclusive jurisdiction of the province—proved a demoralizing blow for Mr. Ross, who, in his reply, denied all around the subject but was careful not to come to close quarters with Mr. Meredith's damaging exposure.

As the resolution moved by Mr. Ross on that occasion was sustained by the whole of the Ontario Reform party, the ground is clear from under them as defenders of provincial rights and opponents of disallowance, and their nakedness is exposed. On the question of the disallowance of some of the delegates to the Mercier Conference, Mr. Meredith was particularly strong, his scintillation of a Ministry that did not hesitate to strike hands with men who would not even sit at the conference table until an 'understanding' had been arranged that they would still be at liberty to labor for the destruction of the Confederation by any means they pleased, was an example of powerful discrimination and forensic eloquence. Indeed, it is difficult to discover in Mr. Meredith's great effort a single weak point. He

did not waste his strength in dealing with the petty details of the resolutions but went straight to the heart of the proposed amendments to the constitution—the disallowance question, the return to 'Downing Street dictation' in regard to local legislation, the proposed destruction of the Federal franchise, the 'reform' of the Senate, and the financial terms—handling every subject with marked ability and cutting out work for every Government speaker that would follow. The fairness of the speaker's point of view to the power of the House dealt at the caucus resolves. The closing appeal to the Ontario opponents of Confederation to abandon their unseemly and mischievous agitation of twenty years and devote their time and talents to the development of the country met with a hearty response in every loyal breast. Altogether, the speech was one worthy of Mr. Meredith's high reputation as a legislator, an orator and a patriot, and worthy of the legislator of the province of Canada.

Departmental Report.

The report of the Postmaster General has been received. The report shows a large increase in numbers of post offices as well as in mileage, there having been 280 new post offices established throughout the Dominion, increasing the total number of post offices in operation to 7,584, and that the mail service has been augmented by the organization of 1,290 miles of additional post route, and of 414,407 miles of additional annual mail travel over the various post routes of Canada.

The number of letters passing through the mails is estimated to have increased to a yearly total of 74,300,000, and of post cards to 16,356,000.

The report also refers to the arrangements entered into for the conveyance of parcels through the mails between Canada and the United States, which was to come into force on the 1st of March, (but of which no official notice appears yet to have been made) the rate of postage to be one cent per ounce prepaid.

In reference to the total revenue and expenditure, the following figures are given:—The Postal Revenue for the year was \$2,003,255, and the expenditure included in the accounts was \$2,458,100, showing deficit of \$454,845. The deficit on the accounts of the year 1886 was \$911,031, a difference in favor of the year of \$456,186. In reference to this, the Postmaster General says:—

"This reduction in the comparative amount of deficit, or insufficiency of the revenue from postal rates to meet the expenditure required for the due maintenance of the postal service, shows a tendency, for the first time since 1883, towards a more comparative rate of increase in revenue than in expenditure."

The estimated number of registered letters passing by mail in Canada during this year was 3,600,000. The casualties affecting safe carriage and delivery applied to 166 cases out of this number, a result which does not vary from the ordinary average of one in every 21,400 letters registered. In this aggregate of casualties are reckoned registered letters lost or destroyed by fire or other accidents while under conveyance, as well as letters stolen by burglars or mislaid by the carrier or lost by the post office.

The total number of money orders of all classes issued during the year was 574,891, an increase over the previous year of 45,441, the amount for which they were issued aggregating \$10,328,283.

Personal.

Thomas Robinson, one of the foremost cartoon artists in the United States, died at Providence, Thursday, of heart trouble and apoplexy, from which he had been suffering some time. He was born in Miramichi, N. B. He was 63 years old and leaves a widow, having married about a year ago.—*St. John Globe*.

Mr. Temple, M. P. for York county, was run down by a toboggan at the Rideau Hall grounds Ottawa, on Tuesday night, the 28th ult. He was severely stunned but escaped with only a few bruises.

Obituary.

Mr. James Johnston, the much respected Postmaster of this town, died at his residence in Newcastle, on Wednesday afternoon, February 29th. About 2 years ago he was thrown from a cart while crossing the railway track and received injuries in his head which gradually led to paralysis, and for some months past he has been almost entirely unconscious, appearing to suffer very much. All that loving and kind attention could do for him was done, and after gradually becoming weaker and more and more helpless the end came. He was 58 years of age. He came to this country when about ten years old with his father and mother and a large family of children, in the fall of the year 1839 or 1840, from Lockerbie, Dumfriesshire, Scotland. They resided in Napier for a few years and then moved to a new farm on the Berthelme where his father and mother yet reside, the former being close on to ninety years of age and the latter over eighty. Mr. Jas. Johnston, taught school in Napier and at Oak Point, in this country, and then came to Newcastle where he taught for about two years, when he accepted the office of Postmaster of the town of Newcastle upon the resignation of Mr. Tuxill, which office he held until his death, a period of about thirty years. He leaves a wife and family of five boys and a girl. Much sympathy is felt for them in their affliction.

Flags at half mast were kept flying over the Post Office and Masonic Hall from the time of the death of Mr. Johnston until after the funeral on Saturday afternoon. On Saturday flags were also flying at half mast from the railway station and at the American Consulate. The deceased was for many years a member of the Northumberland Lodge, No. 17, & A.
