"PREPARED TO MEET MY GOD."

The Dying Man Asserts his Moral Innocence.

The Scene at the Scaffold.—The Deceased's Last Words.

There was a deep gloom about the gaol on Friday last, when George Bennett was executed for the murder of Mrs. Brown. In a firm and calm speech on the scaffold the dying man asserted his innocence, declaring he never intended to injure the deceased woman, and that he was in fact innocent of the crime.

THE CONVICT'S RECORD.

The unfortunate man who has just suffered the extreme penalty of the law, was born in Coburg, and was reputed to be the result of a union between a negro and a white woman. When quite a youth he went to the United States, and served as an engineer for some time.

THE CLIMAX OF CRIMINALITY.

From the correspondence that was subsequently published, it appears that Bennett early in the year gave indications of the growth of a mental disease, the characteristics of which were a morbid, gloomy frame of mind, a firm resolve to commit the crime, and a determination to persist in it.

THE SHOOTING OF MR. BROWN.
