



Only Difference Is Over Scale: Men Say They Went More Than Half Way

The Calgary painters are on strike. They have been negotiating for some time for what they considered a reasonable increase in wages, together with an improvement in working conditions. They have not received an increase in wages in the last seven

After many negotiations and con ferences the painters conceded their demand for a closed shop, and every thing else, except the question of wages, and they say that they were prepared to go more than half way in that.

When nothing further could be done by conference, they called in the fair wage officer. He admitted that their demands were reasonable and just. He suggested that the government would agree to 55 cents on all government ork under contract and 60 cents on all future jobs.

The fair wage officer then conferred with the master painters. Later on he called in the men and suggested a 55-cent wage until April 1, and 57 1-2 cents for the following three months. The employers made a counter-proposition of 55 cents on a contract for 18 months. The men declined to accept

the counter-proposition. The men are not actually on strike, but most of them did not turn up for work on Monday morning. Twenty of the men, which includes the large majority of the men who are out, and other men have recently joined the
