For this reason, we propose to discontinue to supply No. 1 lot at £12 10s, and in future we shall only execute orders for the lots at £51 10s and £103.

We further hereby give notice that from January 1st, 1897, the prices of these lots will be advanced to £60 and £120 respectively.
