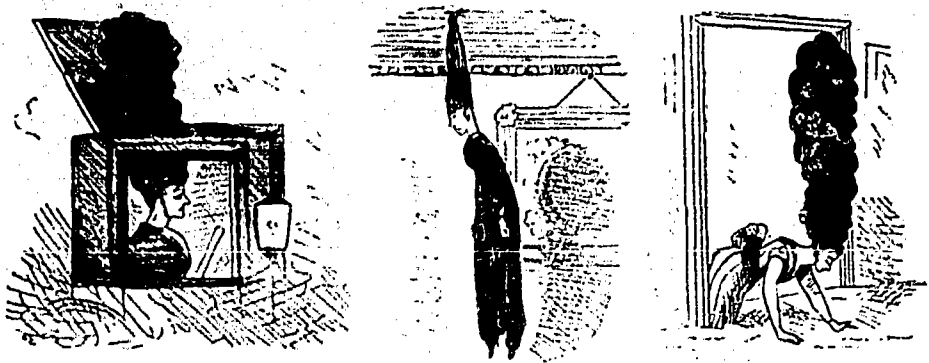


CHIGNONS.
