INDOOR RECREATION

The large Recreation Hall is well provided with comfortable chairs and tables and games such as Chess, Draughts and Dominoes provide plenty of amusement. There is also in this

The Gramaphone is another source of endless enjoyment, as it is provided with a large and varied assortment of Records of classical and popular songs, orchestral selections, recitations and speeches by well-known men.

The large Palm Room opening on to the Terrace is also available in bad weather, as it is comfortably heated and well furnished with chairs, indoor games, newspapers, magazines, etc. With its large windows and doors wide open, this room is very suitable for Fresh Air Treatment for some convalescents who cannot spend much time outdoors even in fine weather.
